The Africa Scout Foundation is an international non-profit organization registered under the Kenya Societies Act, Certificate no. 19668 of 11th February 2000. It was established in 1995 to provide Africa Scout Region with financial support needed for the growth and development of Scouting. This was out of the realization that, Scouting in Africa, if well supported financially, will help more young Africans to develop the knowledge, skills and attitudes that will enable them to be responsible, self-reliant citizens and dependable leaders of the future.

## Our Mission

The mission of the Africa Scout Foundation is to promote the growth of Scouting and support more young people in Africa to gain knowledge, develop skills and attitudes through quality educational programmes towards creating a better world by continuous accumulation of capital fund.

These funds are raised through donations, grants, membership contributions and other legal methods of fundraising. The Foundation also seeks non-capital donations to support specific Scouting projects.

## Our Objectives

To achieve its mission, the foundation pursues the following objectives:

1. To contribute to the general budget and sustainability of the World Scout Bureau Africa Support Centre
2. To contribute to the strategic goal of making Scouting the world's leading educational youth movement, enabling 100 million young people to be active citizens creating positive change in their communities and in the world based on shared values.
3. To win support for the movement in Africa by raising awareness on the role of Scouting in the lives of young people and society as a whole.

## What We Do

The Africa Scout Foundation in fulfilling its objectives engages in the following major activities:

1. Mobilizing financial resources, material and technical support available in Africa and beyond for the benefit of Scouting
2. Developing partnerships and harness individual and corporate support from friends of Scouting in and outside Africa
3. Sensitizing the society on the role of the Foundation in supporting growth and development of Scouting in Africa
4. Recruiting, properly managing and frequently updating members of the Foundation on its progress.

## Cooperation

The Africa Scout Foundation has direct contact and fully cooperates with World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM) through the Africa Scout Committee, having a sole objective which is to help develop Scouting in the Africa Region.

It undertakes to allocate all proceeds from income accruing from its endowment to the World Scout Bureau Africa Support Centre; although a small portion may be retained as a safeguard against inflation or devaluation of investments, or, if necessary, to cover the costs of its own operations.

## Membership Categories

There are four types of membership categories; Junior, Individual, Corporate and Scout Association. In each category, a provision has been made for members to grow in a seven-stage system starting from Copper to Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum, Emerald and Diamond.

Although Copper is the starting point for each of the categories, it does not mean that a member must start from Copper. One is free to enter from any of the stages.

However, the ranks allow for gradual contributions with the highest being the diamond membership. Members who wish to make contributions above and beyond the category payments are also welcome to do so.

## Our Impact



### Africa Scout Foundation Youth Fund

In 2020, the Africa Scout Foundation launched a USD 30,000 Youth Fund, through an open-call for Scout-led projects that promote education of active citizens creating positive change in their communities.



The call received submissions from 209 Scouts from 24 countries from which 16 projects were funded. The projects' focus varied from response to COVID-19 pandemic to youth programme activities, Better World Framework initiatives and local awareness campaigns focusing on education and creating a culture of peace and all the shortlisted projects demonstrate an aspect of community involvement.

### Support for Mozambique

The Foundation paid USD 630 to offset two-year WOSM Fees arrears for Liga dos Escuteiros de Moçambique (LEMO) to enable lifting of their suspension to allow them access Messengers of Peace funding for their [humanitarian action response to Cyclone Idai](#).



### WSB Africa Institutional Support Grant

The Board in July 2022 approved the first ever institutional grant support of USD 21,465 to the World Scout Bureau Africa Support Centre as guided by its objectives. These funds will be used for operational activities of the office.

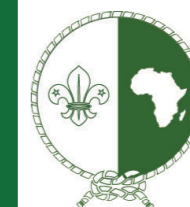
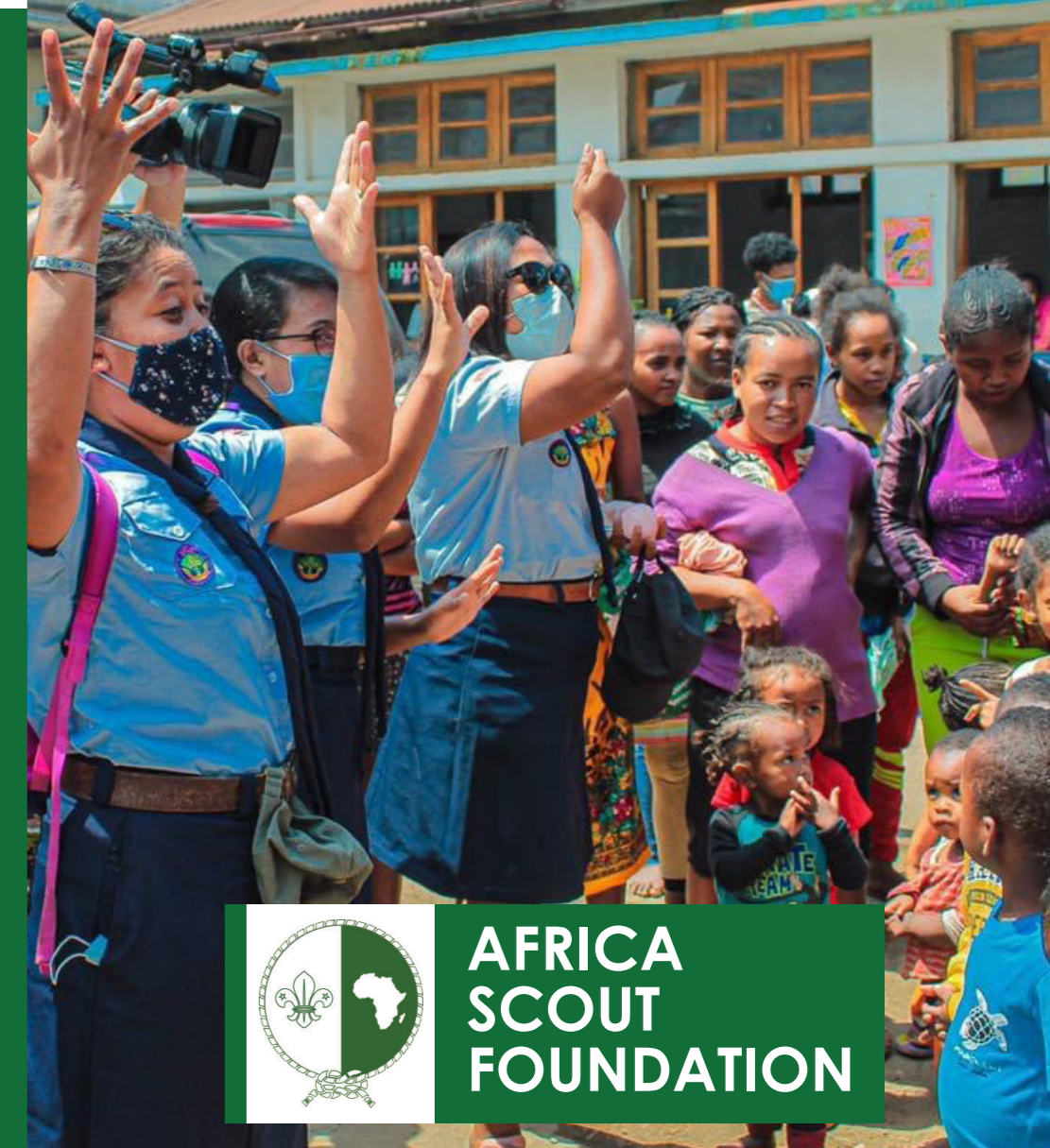
